Applications are to be submitted to the FASA Council, PRAC committee and SAGC committee in January - February of the winter semester. Awards will be provided in March, following the end of the application period. All information submitted will be held in confidence and used solely for the purpose of scholarship administration.

Instructions:

- This is a writable PDF. You will be able to save your work and edit your responses if you use Adobe Acrobat or another PDF editing application; otherwise, you must print the application after it has been completed. You may also print the application and fill it out by hand. Make sure your handwriting is legible. All applications are submitted by email.
- 2. Print or type your name and program on each page.
- 3. Print, type or create a media form to answer the question on page 4 of this document and include it with your application. The creative aspect of your application must be original, in the applicant's own words, and written or produced by the applicant.
- 4. Complete all information. Failure to do so may result in elimination.
- 5. Completed applications are to be submitted by February 18th, 2023 to the email address below. This application is made up of two components, including this completed form and your creative component.

Applicants must:

- 1. Be enrolled in the Faculty of Arts at the University of Calgary.
- 2. Be in good academic standing and not on Academic Probation.
- 3. May be in any year of study.
- 4. Be able to provide an academic reference upon request.

The winner of this scholarship will receive \$1,500.00. The applicant that receives the second-place position will receive \$250.00.
